

Brightwater Supported Independent Living Site Information

Brightwater supports people with complex disabilities, including neurological, cognitive, psychosocial and physical disabilities.

We are an innovator in the area of acquired brain injury rehabilitation, and also provide specialist supported independent living for people with acquired brain injury Huntington's disease.

All of our homes are:

- Accessible and functional, with modifications like hoists, ramps and handles available if required.
- Close to local amenities, community services and public transport.
- Equipped with a shared computer and WiFi access.
- Supported by trained Brightwater staff, including sleepover shifts and overnight assistance.
- Close-knit and cosy housing complexes with a range of configurations.
- Shared and each client has their own room.
- If you have NDIS or private funding, we can also help you access allied health services including physiotherapy, occupational therapy, social work and more.

We have two supported independent living sites specialising in services for people living with Huntington's disease and six supported independent living sites supporting clients with acquired brain injury.

Please see below for support levels for each site:

- **Balcatta** A cluster of three houses, each with up to four adults with brain injury who have medium to high physical support needs.
- **Bentley** A cluster of two bedroom units for adults with brain injury who access the community independently and require mostly light supports and prompting.
- **Cannington** (Hamilton House) A family style shared house for up to six adults with brain injury who have light physical support needs.
- Kailis House (Belmont) A newly refurbished home offering support for six adults with complex neurological disability who have medium support needs.
- **Kingsley** A five-bedroom community home designed for people living with Younger Onset Dementia.
- **Manning** A duplex of four bedroom houses for adults with brain injury who have medium to high physical support needs.
- **Maylands** A duplex of 3 bedroom houses for adults with brain injury who have medium to high physical support needs.
- Piara Waters A group of 7 homes designed for people with Huntington's Disease.
- Warnbro A duplex of 6 bedroom houses for adults with brain injury who have medium to high physical support needs.

Balcatta

A community house for adults with medium support needs.

Nestled north of the river and surrounded by plush green gardens, Brightwater Balcatta is a supported community house for adults with complex disabilities.

Consisting of 3 spacious houses, Brightwater Balcatta is a comfortable place for 12 people to call home. Our housemates have medium support needs and live their lives as independently as possible, with extra support for day-to-day activities including assisted lifting with or without hoists.

Bentley

A community house for adults with light support needs.

Our housemates require light support and live their lives as independently as possible, including independently accessing local shops, going to the gym and participating in disability employment activities.

Each Brightwater community house is fully equipped and accessible, close to public transport and supported by trained Brightwater team members who will encourage you to connect with your community and reach your potential.



Piara Waters

A group of 7 homes designed for people with Huntington's Disease.

Opened in mid-2024, Brightwater Piara Waters is a world-class campus purpose-built to support people with Huntington's Disease.

Piara Waters' residential campus includes 21 bedrooms and ensuites in seven houses, each with specialist assistive equipment and leading-edge technology. The homes in this exclusive Huntington's Disease gated community are certified Specialist Disability



Accommodation for people with extreme functional impairment or very high needs.

Each private room is designed for purpose and comfort, with a personal TV and built-in cabinetry with storage. Rooms are accessibility enabled and prepared for hoist installation if necessary. The contemporary layout provides personal privacy and light touch support from staff, while fostering a sense of community with neighbours in shared living spaces.

Residents enjoy a sensory garden with zones for living, relaxing and socialising. Plenty of parking to encourage visitors and security features at key entry points provide peace of mind for residents, their families and friends.
